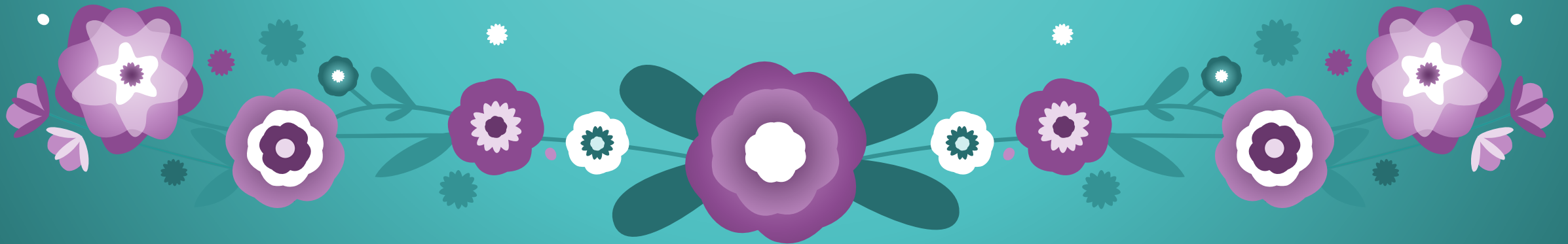




Lewes in Bloom Volunteer of the Year



Rationale

Objective and Method

We will recognize 1-3 LIB volunteers per year at the Annual Luncheon.

Members will have the opportunity to nominate volunteers:

1. an online (or down-loadable) form and
2. through a form that can be filled out at the September LIB General Meeting.



Criteria

- The volunteer must have logged more than 100 hours or more through LIB's online Volunteer Hour collection;
- The volunteer must **ALSO** have shown **LEADERSHIP** in one or more of the following areas:
 - Art in Bloom
 - Beauty Spot
 - Children's Learning Garden
 - Committees
 - Communications
 - Education/Programs
 - Events (Tulip Celebration, May Plant Sale, Christmas Wreath Sale, Christmas Market, etc)
 - Financial
 - Fundraising
 - Garden Tour(s)
 - Horticulture
 - Membership
 - Merchandise
 - Scholarship
 - Social (Happy Hours, evening cruise, fashion show, bus trips, etc.)
 - Merchandise
 - Scholarship

Or -- The volunteer must have logged more than 100 hours through LIB's online Volunteer Hour collection and

- must ALSO have been involved in one or more SPECIAL INITIATIVES that contribute to Lewes in Bloom such as:
- Carpentry
- Competitions
- Planting / Weeding / Mulching
- Warehouse
- Watering
